





In our last update, we announced that demolition had begun. Since then, the buildings have transformed and the vision has started to take tangible shape.



Drop-In Center


With computers readily available, this space will be where children and families can work on schoolwork, job readiness, job placement, assessment et al.


CONSTRUCTION UPDATE




ANGEL AND YADIRA'S STORY


